BRIDGE PROGRAM

A.S.-B.S. bridge program for working Respiratory Therapists with A.S. degree and R.R.T. credential who want to complete a bachelor's degree

Course content focuses on specialty areas of respiratory therapy:

- Adult Critical Care Disease Management Pulmonary Functions

- Asthma Education
 - Neonatal and Pediatrics Leadership

Program includes partially online courses: students only come to campus once a month, with the rest of the course work completed online

Prepares graduates for the National Board of Respiratory Care specialty exams

13 COURSES FROM YOUR B.S. DEGREE

Your Registered Respiratory Therapy (R.R.T.) credential and A.S. or A.A.S. in respiratory therapy from an accredited program *together* count toward 21 course credit hours, which you can apply toward a bachelor of science in respiratory therapy, pending transcript approval.

That means you may be only 13 courses away from completing the B.S. degree!

During the admissions process, an audit of your college transcripts takes place so you know exactly what classes you need to take in order to complete a 4-year degree in respiratory therapy.
